



RoboCup Québec Canada 2024 Robotics Competition

Parental Consent and Release Agreement for Participation

The "Participant" identified below wishes to participate as a team member, student, coach, mentor, judge, or in some other manner in the RoboCup Québec Canada Event (also abbreviated as RCJ Québec). As a condition for the Participant to attend and/or compete in this event, the Participant requires his or her Parent/Guardian (if under 18 years of age) to agree to the terms of this Consent and Release Agreement.

- 1. The Participant (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age) understands that the participation in such an event could expose the Participant to risks of injury including, without limitation, injury from; building, lifting, and using electrical/mechanical robots and robot components; other participants; and associated activities. Participants (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age) understands that RoboCup Québec Canada, as a non-profit organization, employs, supervises or otherwise exercises authority or control over the coaches, mentors, and other participants at the event. Participant, if 18 years of age or older, acknowledges and agrees that he/she is primarily responsible for his/her safety. The Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age acknowledges and agrees that the Parent/Guardian is primarily responsible for the Participant's safety and that the Parent/Guardian will monitor, as appropriate, considering the age of the Participant and other factors, the Participant's participation in the event.
- 2. In allowing the Participant to participate in the Event, the Participant (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age for and on behalf of the Participant and the Parent/Guardian) assumes all risk of such participation. Alike, he or she hereby releases RoboCup Québec Canada and (except as expressly provided below) all of its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, and agents from any and all claims for any injury of any kind to the Participant (and the Parent/Guardian) or other damages that may occur as a result of the Participant's competition in the Event. This would include, without limitation any injuries or other damages that may be caused by the negligence of RoboCup Québec Canada or negligence of any of its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, or agents (including without limitation negligently failing to adequately investigate or screen coaches, mentors, volunteers, etc.). The Parent/Guardian agrees not to file any lawsuit or otherwise make any claim against RoboCup Québec Canada or its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, or agents for any such injury or other damages.
- 3. The Participant (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age) understands that photographs, videotapes, and other recordings may be made of participants in the Event. Participants (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age) consents to those photographs, videos, and other recordings and the use thereof: (i) as part of a record of the Event and (ii) to promote RoboCup Québec Canada activities (iii) for school use.

The participant (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age) has read this document and understands that this <u>Consent and Release Agreement</u> which includes a waiver of the right to make injury claims and is intended to be legally binding.
